Ten-Year Arrest Trends, Totals, 1999–2008

- A comparison of the number of persons arrested in 2008 to the number of those arrested in 1999 showed a 0.1 percent increase.
- The number of adults arrested in 2008 increased 3.4 percent when compared to the number of adults arrested in 1999.
- The number of juveniles (those under age 18) arrested in 2008 dropped 15.7 percent when compared to the 1999 figure.
- Overall, the number of arrests for violent crimes declined 4.9 percent when compared to the 1999 figure.
- The number of persons arrested for forcible rape in 2008 fell 19.3 percent when compared to 1999 arrest figures.
- The number of persons arrested for robbery in 2008 rose 20.6 percent when compared to 1999 arrest data.
- The number of persons arrested for property crimes increased 1.7 percent in 2008 when compared with data for 1999.
- The number of arrests for motor vehicle theft declined 26.1 percent when compared with figures for 1999.
