Arrests, Persons Under 15, 18, 21, and 25 Years of Age, 2009

- In 2009, individuals under the age of 25 accounted for 43.6 percent of all arrestees.
- Individuals under the age of 25 comprised 44.7 percent of all arrests for violent crime, 48.9 percent of all arrests for murder, and 65.2 percent of arrests for robbery.
- Persons under the age of 25 accounted for 55.8 percent of all arrests for property crime, 60.3 percent of arrests for burglary, and 64.3 percent of arrests for arson.
- In 2009, 26.1 percent of all persons arrested for arson were under the age of 15, and 55.4 were under the age of 21 years.
- Arrests of persons under the age of 25 comprised 46.8 percent of all arrests made for drug abuse violations.
