



## **U.S. Capitol Police**

In 2005, 12 officers with the U.S. Capitol Police were assaulted. Seven officers sustained injuries in the attacks.

### **Type of Activity**

Officers with the U.S. Capitol Police were performing the following activities at the time of their attacks:

- 6 officers were attempting arrests or serving summonses.
- 4 officers were maintaining custody of prisoners.
- 2 officers were involved in investigations or searches.

### **Weapons**

- 8 of the 12 officers were assaulted with personal weapons such as hands, fists, or feet.
- 1 officer was attacked with a vehicle.
- 3 officers were attacked with other types of dangerous weapons.

### **Disposition Information**

Law enforcement authorities arrested 12 suspects for assaulting U.S. Capitol Police officers; all the suspects had the charges against them dropped or were found not guilty.
