

On September 20, 1991, this female victim was recovered in a vacant lot near a hospital in Staten Island, New York. She was wearing a black 3/4-length dress with a pink-colored collar and pockets, Thom McAnn “balloon” sneakers, two gold necklaces, and a ring with a small watch face. The victim had a tattoo of a scorpion on her right buttock.

Law enforcement agencies should bring this information to the attention of all missing persons units and crime analysis units. A dental chart is available, and the victim’s DNA has been registered with the FBI’s National Missing & Unidentified Person DNA Database.
