Clothes/Jewelry/Possessions: The only item of clothing located with the remains was a black bra. No jewelry or other items were recovered with the remains.

Details of Discovery: A human skull and other small bones were discovered in a wooded area to the rear of an industrial location occupied by a Goodyear tire re-tread business. The area had previously been backfilled with construction debris but nothing had reportedly been dumped there for approximately 20 years. Upon removing debris, the skeletal remains of a torso were discovered wrapped in carpet.
